Rules and Regulations

1. 6 members per team with 2 alternates - (total 4 males / 4 females)
(alternates only play if there is an injury)
2. \$15.00 per team member purchased prior to 9/1/2007, however it will cost \$20.00 the day of the event.
3. Team members must be 18 years old or a signed consent by a parent/guardian. (Consent must be signed in the presence of a FACT board member on the day of event.)

Impartial judges and time keepers will be recruited by FACT. They will have badges and will be rotated with events. **Volunteer judges call Carl Mancino , Chairman of the Team Competition, at (610) 730-9155**

All team captains and their members must be checked in between 11:30 and Noon!

Check in will be at the tennis court, see Carl Mancino. The names of the 2 alternates must be submitted prior to the games. If you fail to submit the names, you will not be able to substitute if one of your team members has dropped out of the competition. One of your team members will have to go twice.

Scoring of Events
